SV2 PROVIDES HELP TO VICTIMS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE

At Millfield House, we will support you regardless of when your experience of sexual violence occurred.

Our services support all genders from any age and we can refer you on to SV2's specialist counselling service.

You do not have to report the abuse to the police to get support from us. However, if you do want to report the crime, we can support you through the reporting process, during the forensic examination if one is needed, through the investigation and when you are in court.

SV2 will help you access other services when you need them and we can provide you with specialist counselling that helps you come to terms with the crime.

SV2 also works with young people to raise their understanding of what 'consent' means.

We do not work with perpetrators of sexual violence of any gender.
