CONSENT WORKSHOPS

SV2 delivers consent workshops to Year 9 and above in a variety of educational settings across Derbyshire.

We believe that understanding consent helps to form healthy relationships and dispels societal myths about sexual abuse and rape.

The workshops are a combination of discussions, activities and videos. We encourage healthy debates and the opportunity to explore ideas.

The workshop gives the young people a safe place to voice their opinions, ask questions and know they will be listened to.

At the end of the workshop young people will have a better understanding of consent and how to access support.

We offer tailored content for different year groups right up to undergraduate students.

TRAINING & AWARENESS FOR PROFESSIONALS

We believe it is important for professionals to understand the impact of abuse and rape. Our sessions aim to help professionals feel more confident when responding to disclosures.

We will provide information about SV2 services, how we can support those affected by sexual abuse/rape and how to make a referral.

As part of the session our Learning and Development Officers will raise awareness of various trauma responses to help dispel myths and challenge societal views.
